



HEALTH WARRANTY & SALES CONTRACT

This Health Warranty & Sales Contract ("Agreement") is entered into between **South Paw Doodles** ("Seller") and [Buyer Name] ("Buyer") regarding the sale of the puppy identified below.

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1. GENERAL HEALTH GUARANTEE

Seller guarantees that, at the time of delivery, the puppy is in good general health and has received appropriate veterinary care, including age-appropriate vaccinations, deworming, and microchipping.

Seller shall provide available veterinary records and vaccine information to Buyer.

Buyer agrees to have the puppy examined by a licensed veterinarian within three (3) business days of receipt. Failure to obtain this examination within the required timeframe shall void this Health Warranty in its entirety.

If the puppy is found during this initial examination to have a serious illness or condition existing prior to transfer, Buyer must notify Seller immediately and provide complete veterinary documentation. Upon confirmation by Seller's veterinarian, Buyer may return the puppy at Buyer's expense for a refund of the purchase price only. Any shipping, delivery, veterinary, or related expenses are non-refundable.



2. TWO-YEAR GENETIC HEALTH WARRANTY

Seller provides a two (2) year warranty from the puppy's date of birth against serious hereditary or congenital genetic defects that significantly shorten the puppy's life expectancy or severely diminish quality of life.

Covered conditions include serious life-altering genetic disorders confirmed by a licensed veterinarian and determined to be hereditary in nature.

If a covered condition is diagnosed within the warranty period, Buyer must:

1. Notify Seller in writing within five (5) business days of diagnosis;
2. Provide complete veterinary records and diagnostic documentation; and
3. Allow Seller the right to obtain a second opinion from a veterinarian of Seller's choosing, at Seller's expense.

Upon verification of a covered genetic defect, Seller shall provide, at Seller's sole discretion:

- A replacement puppy from a future litter of comparable value; or
- A refund of up to seventy-five percent (75%) of the original purchase price.

Under no circumstances shall Seller be responsible for veterinary expenses, emotional damages, incidental damages, consequential damages, or any amount exceeding the original purchase price of the puppy.

3. HIP DYSPLASIA WARRANTY

Seller provides a two (2) year warranty against severe hereditary hip dysplasia.

Buyer must provide official documentation from OFA, PennHIP, or another recognized veterinary orthopedic evaluation service confirming the diagnosis.

This warranty shall be void if:

- The dog is overweight;
- The dog's joints have been overstressed through excessive exercise, improper activity, injury, or poor nutrition; or
- Veterinary records indicate environmental or injury-related causes contributed to the condition.

Seller reserves the right to confirm all findings before issuing any refund or replacement.



4. CONDITIONS NOT COVERED

This Warranty does not cover:

- Minor, cosmetic, dental, or non-life-threatening conditions;
- Fleas, worms, parasites, giardia, coccidia, allergies, ear infections, or stress-related illnesses;
- Hypoglycemia, stress diarrhea, or illnesses resulting from relocation or transport;
- Tooth alignment issues, retained baby teeth, underbites, overbites, dental abnormalities, hernias, undescended testicles, or cosmetic defects;
- Size, weight, color, coat type, shedding level, or breeding quality;
- Injuries, accidents, neglect, abuse, improper care, poor nutrition, obesity, overexertion, or environmental causes.

All veterinary care and associated costs after transfer of ownership are solely the responsibility of Buyer.

5. SPAY / NEUTER AGREEMENT

All puppies are sold strictly as companion pets on a non-breeding contract unless otherwise agreed to in writing by Seller prior to purchase.

Buyer agrees:

- To spay a female puppy by nine (9) months of age; or
- To neuter a male puppy by twelve (12) months of age.

Proof of spay/neuter must be provided to Seller by email at: _____

Failure to comply with this spay/neuter agreement shall immediately void this Health Warranty unless a separate written Breeder's Rights Addendum has been executed.

Buyer agrees that any legal fees or court costs incurred by Seller in enforcing this non-breeding agreement shall be the sole responsibility of Buyer.



6. BUYER RESPONSIBILITIES

Buyer agrees to:

- Maintain the puppy in good health;
- Provide routine veterinary care and vaccinations;
- Feed a premium-quality dog food;
- Maintain the dog at a healthy weight;
- Provide proper housing, exercise, grooming, and humane treatment.

The dog shall never be neglected, abused, or continuously chained outdoors.

Failure to provide reasonable preventative and maintenance care shall void this Warranty.

7. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

Under no circumstances shall Seller be liable to Buyer or any third party for any indirect, incidental, special, or consequential damages arising from or related to this puppy.

Seller makes no guarantees beyond those expressly stated in this Agreement.

8. GOVERNING LAW

This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of _____.

9. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

This Agreement represents the entire understanding between the parties and supersedes all prior discussions, representations, or agreements.

No modification to this Agreement shall be valid unless made in writing and signed by both parties.
